## **PLAN SUMMARY STATEMENT**

This plan summary accurately reflects the content of the toxic substance reduction plan for Butane, Dimethylether, Ethyl alcohol, Isopropyl alcohol, Pentane (all isomers) and Propane prepared by K-G Spray-Pak Inc. dated June 16, 2015.

### **STATEMENT OF INTENT**

K-G Spray-Pak Inc. is committed to protecting the environment and dedicated to reducing the use and creation of toxic substances wherever technically and economically viable. Our employees are encouraged to participate in all types of toxic substance reduction activities. We will continue to monitor technological advancements to ensure that options that are both technologically and financially viable are implemented at our facility.

### **REDUCTION OBJECTIVES**

K-G Spray-Pak Inc. does not currently intend to reduce the use or creation of these toxic substances at the facility because no technically and economically feasible reduction options could be identified.

### **DESCRIPTION OF SUBSTANCES**

K-G Spray-Pak Inc. manufactures aerosol products in Mississauga, Ontario. Butane, Dimethylether, Ethyl alcohol, Isopropyl alcohol, Pentane (all isomers) and Propane are components of the aerosol product formulation.

No technically and economically feasible reduction options were identified, so therefore no reduction options are to be implemented at this time.
